The instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondent No.2 to decide the appeal dated 10.07.2023 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner against the order dated 16.06.2023 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.1 imposing a punishment of stoppage of one annual increment with cumulative effect.

Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset prays for deciding the appeal filed by the petitioner dated 10.07.2023 (Annexure P-2) expeditiously by passing a speaking order within a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Avinit Avasthi, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondents and filed his *memo of appearance*, and submits that the appeal filed by the petitioner shall be decided within a period of three months.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through

the record of the case.
