MEENAKSHI I. MEHTA, J.(Oral)

The petitioner herein has sought the relief of anticipatory bail in the criminal case arisen out of the FIR bearing No.41 dated 19.07.2022 as registered at Police Station Women Patiala, District Patiala, under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC.

2. It is pertinent to mention here that on 02.12.2022, the Co-ordinate Bench had ordered that no coercive action would be taken against the petitioner. Today, learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Balkar Singh from the above-referred Police Station, informs the Court that the petitioner has joined in the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required and he is also not involved in any other criminal case.

3. As per the report of the Mediator submitted in pursuance of the afore-said order dated 02.12.2022, the parties have settled their dispute amicably. The written settlement/agreement has also been annexed with the said report.

4. In view of the above-discussed facts and circumstances, the petition in hand is allowed and petitioner-Manpreet Singh is granted the relief of anticipatory bail subject to his furnishing the requisite personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer.

5. However, he shall strictly abide by the following conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C:-

- “(i) He shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
- (ii) He shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat and promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court to any police officer;*
- (iii) He shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court.”*
