By way of present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., petitioner prays for grant of bail in case G.D. No.19 dated 29.06.2023 registered under Sections 452/427/380/336/506/148/149 IPC (later on added offence under Section 307 IPC) & 25/27 of Arms Act, 1959 cross case version arisen out of FIR No.81 dated 29.06.2023 under Section 323/452/427/380/506/148/149 IPC & 25/27 of Arms Act, 1959 (later on added offence under Section 307 IPC, 1860) at Police Station Jhabal, Tehsil and District Tarn Taran, Punjab.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner was not initially named in the cross version to the FIR No.81 dated 29.06.2023. Learned counsel further contends that matter has already been compromised between the parties and quashing petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C has also been filed in which this Court vide order dated 31.07.2023 passed in CRM-M-37115 of 2023, directed the parties to appear before the trial Court for getting the statements recorded regarding the compromise.

Learned State Counsel does not refute the contentions as raised by learned counsel for the petitioner. Custody certificate placed on record by learned State Counsel reveals that petitioner is in custody for the last 02 months and 03 days and he has no criminal antecedents.

Having regard to the afore-said facts and circumstances of the case, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/ Duty Magistrate concerned.
