ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.13 dated 02.11.2020, under Sections 409, 420, 465, 466, 467, 471, 120-B IPC and 7, 7(a) of Prevention of Corruption Act, and Section 82, 83 of the Registration Act, 1908, registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, Flying Squad 1, Punjab Mohali.

2. Counsel for the petitioner wants to withdraw the present petition on the ground that he has been arrested by the Enforcement Directorate in relation to the same allegations. He further submits that as of now, it appears that State is not intending to arrest him.

3. On this, counsel for the State submits that whether they intend to arrest or not, it is matter that requires consideration.

4. In the entirety of facts and circumstances of the case, the present petition is disposed of as withdrawn. It is clarified that if the State /Investigator wants to arrest the petitioner in the present case, they can do so by issuing seven days advance notice. This order shall come into force only when the petitioner is
