In pursuance to the orders passed by this Court, affidavit of the Deputy Commissioner, SAS Nagar, Mohali dated 14.04.2023, had been earlier filed in Court, where in para-1, it has been stated as follows:-

“1. That the answering deponent has already filed two affidavits i.e. on 24.01.2023 and 15.02.2023 regarding the above-said petition in this Hon'ble Court and in continuation of that affidavits, it is submitted that the three different dates were fixed by the Tehsildar, Mohali to auction the land in question of the respondent No. 4 but nobody came forward to participate in the auction proceedings. Copy of the proceedings initiated by the Tehsildar on 6.3.2023 i.e. on third time along with letter no. 13 dated 9.3.2023 vide which intimation was sent to the Deputy Commissioner, List of the Members present at the time

of auction, Auction Report and copy of the Rojnamcha Waquiti are attached as Annexure R-7 (Colly) and true translated copy of the same is Annexure R-7 (Colly).”

It is, on this basis, that the auction could not be finalized.

Learned counsel for the State submits that the report, in this regard, would be submitted to the competent authority and thereafter, proceeded as per the orders/directions received from the same.

In the light of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of at this stage.
