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KARAMJIT SINGH, J. (Oral)

1. Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case having FIR No.111 dated 23.06.2022 registered under Sections 307, 452, 324, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, at Police Station Division No.5, District Jalandhar.
2. The petitioners were granted interim bail with direction to join investigation by this Court vide detailed order dated 30.9.2022.

3. Counsel for the petitioners *inter alia* contends that no grievous injury has been attributed to the petitioners and they have joined investigation with the police by virtue of previous order of interim bail passed by this Court.
4. State counsel on instructions from ASI Vipan Kumar submits that only simple injuries are attributed to the petitioners, who have already joined the investigation and now the petitioners are not required by police for further investigation or for custodial interrogation and the recovery of weapon used in commission of crime is already effected.
5. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby allowed and order dated 30.09.2022 is hereby made absolute. The petitioners should abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
