1. This petition was filed seeking quashing of order dated 15.7.2019 declaring the petitioner proclaimed person in FIR No. 175 dated 20.9.2016 under Sections 323/324/341/506/34 IPC, 1860.

2. On 19.9.2019, the following order was passed :-

‘Contends that the petitioner is ready to join proceedings before the learned trial Court.

Notice of motion returnable on 20.12.2019.

In the meantime, petitioner is directed to join proceedings before learned Trial Court and be released on interim bail, till the next date of hearing, subject to its satisfaction.’

3. On 19.9.2023, learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Lal submitted that in pursuance to the directions of this Court the petitioner has not joined the proceedings before the Trial Court. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he had no instructions. On his request, the matter was adjourned.

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4. Today None has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner in spite of two pass overs.
5. In view of the above, the petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
6. Since the main case has been dismissed for non-prosecution the pending application(s), if any is rendered infructuous.
