The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for setting aside the order dated 07.07.2022 (Annexure P-1) whereby the bail of the petitioner was cancelled and his bail bonds were forfeited in FIR No.475 dated 07.10.2012 under Sections 420, 467, 568 and 471 IPC at Police Station City Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

On 10.10.2022, the following order was passed:-

“The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.PCis for setting aside the order dated 07.07.2022 (Annexure P-1) whereby the bail of the petitioner was cancelled and his bail bonds were forfeited in FIR No.475 dated 07.10.2012 under Sections 420, 467, 568 and 471 IPC at Police Station City Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

The Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had noted the wrong date, therefore, he was unable to appear before the Trial Court on 07.07.2022, on which date the impugned order was passed. He

states that the petitioner is ready and willing to join the proceedings once again.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court within a period of one week from today subject to a deposit of Rs.10,000/- as costs with the Chandi Kusht Ashram Society, Shiv Ram Mandir (Lapriosy Colony), Sector 47, Opp. 3 BRD Gate, Chandigarh and on his doing so he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.”

Pursuant to the aforementioned order, the petitioner has appeared and furnished his requisite bail bonds/surety bonds. The copy of the order dated 11.10.2022 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri is marked as 'X'.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

It is expected that the petitioner shall not absent himself from Trial without sufficient cause.
