Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant criminal writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus with a prayer to direct respondents No.1 and 2 to ensure the protection of life and liberty of the petitioners and his family members at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent No.2 is directed to consider the representation dated 27.08.2023 (Annexure P-1) and decide the same by passing an appropriate order thereon, in accordance with law.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the present criminal writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala-respondent No.2, to look into the matter, consider the representation (Annexure P-1) and decide the same as early as possible by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law.

With the above-said directions issued, the instant writ petition stands disposed of.
