This is the fifth petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking grant of regular bail in FIR No.124 dated 06.08.2020, registered for offence under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short “NDPS Act”), however, later on Section 29 of NDPS Act was added, at Police Station Jaito, District Faridkot, Punjab, Annexure P-1.

Upon instructions received from ASI, Gurdeep Singh, State counsel submits that a recovery of 1500 tablets was effected from a car driven by the petitioner. He submits that the petitioner was found to be the owner of the vehicle and the weight of the contraband recovered was found to be 616 grams of Tramadol. Upon further instructions, he submits that on a confessional statement of the petitioner, a recovery of 18500 tablets, weighing more than 8 kgs of Tramadol, was effected from co-accused, Bittu son of Naib Singh. He submits that seven out of twenty five prosecution witnesses have been examined.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition.
