1. By way of present appeal, challenge has been laid to the judgments and decrees dated 14.08.2010 and 23.02.2012 passed by the Courts below, whereby, a suit for declaration and permanent injunction filed at the instance of respondents-plaintiffs, stood dismissed.

2. On 05.02.2020, this Court passed the following order:-

“Respondents No. 1 and 4 are reported to be dead. As per office report, notices sent to respondents No. 2 and 3 have been received back unserved with the report that they are not residing at the given address, whereas notice sent to respondent No.6 has been received unserved with the report that his address is incomplete.

Let current and correct address of respondents No. 2,3 and 6 be furnished within three weeks and thereafter fresh notices be sent to the said respondents for 06.05.2020.

In the meantime, let necessary steps be taken for the impleadment of legal representatives of respondents No. 1 and 4.

However, it is clarified that in case needful is not done before the next date of hearing, present appeal shall stand dismissed for non-prosecution.”

3. Admittedly, no steps have been taken at the instance of appellant as regards furnishing of correct address of respondents No.2, 3 and 6 in terms of order dated 05.02.2020, resultantly, in terms thereof, no further orders are required to be passed and the present appeal is dismissed for non-prosecution for non-compliance of aforesaid order.
