1. The present petition has been filed for directions to respondents No. 1 to 5 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of private respondents No. 6 to 8 and their companions.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners after arguing for some time, is not pressing the present petition but seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law including approaching the Incharge of the police station for registration of FIR.

3. Dismissed as not pressed with liberty as prayed for.

4. Since the main case has been dismissed as not pressed, pending application if any is rendered infructuous.

5. There is no doubt that in the eventuality of the petitioners availing remedies in accordance with Cr.P.C., the same would be considered in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible.
