Petitioner was seeking issuance of appropriate directions to the respondents to file status report in case bearing FIR No.39 dated 08.04.2020 under Sections 324, 341, 506, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Jaitu, District Faridkot.

It had been submitted that the accused named in the aforesaid FIR had been roaming around freely and extending threats of dire consequences to the petitioner.

Learned State counsel has drawn the attention of this Court to the status report dated 12.12.2021 filed by way of affidavit of Varun Sharma, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police Faridkot and has submitted that subsequent to registration of the FIR in question, an investigation was carried out on the basis of which Chamkaur Singh

and Arshdeep Singh, who were named in the FIR, stood re-arrested; however, two other accused Jashandeep Singh and Swaran Singh are still at large and efforts are being made to apprehend all the remaining accused, for which repeated raids are being carried out by the police.

In view of the report submitted on behalf of the respondents and the submissions made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would not press the instant petition and he be permitted to withdraw with liberty to avail of alternate remedy under the provisions of law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as aforesaid.
