The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.320 dated 22.12.2018 under Sections 306 IPC and Section 201 IPC (added later on), registered at Police Station Yamuna Nagar Sadar, District Yamuna Nagar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 13.10.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 13.10.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 13.10.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
