ANOOP CHITKARA, J.

Seeking quashing of FIR No.20 dated 19.10.2022, registered under Sections 420, 465, 466, 468, 471, 120B IPC read with Section 7 of Prevention of Corruption Act, the petitioner has come up before this Court under Section 482 CrPC.

2. After arguing for some time, counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh application before the trial Court, in which he would place on record his posting orders to depict that at the time of allegations, he was not even posted at that particular place. He further prays that he be permitted to appear through his counsel.

3. Given above, petition is disposed of as withdrawn with liberty to file an application before the trial Court by mentioning the above said details. It is clarified that if such application is filed within 15 days from today, the trial Court shall decide the same on priority before proceeding further in the matter. The petitioner is also permitted to appear through his counsel unless explicitly directed by the Sessions Court to appear in person, subject to the condition that petitioner shall neither seek any adjournment nor claim any prejudice in this regard. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
