The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing vide DDR/Rapat No.31 dated 04.12.2020 registered under Sections 307, 323, 382, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25 & 27 of Arms Act in FIR No.0336 dated 29.11.2020 registered under Sections 307, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25 & 27 of Arms Act at Police Station Kathu Nangal, District Amritsar Rural.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 30.09.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Nirmal Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.
