AVNEESH JHINGAN, J.(Oral)

1. This petition is filed seeking regular bail in case of FIR No. 15, dated 12.6.2021, under Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Intelligence Wing (CID), State Special Operation Cell, Amritsar.
2. One of the main ground for seeking bail is that trial is not proceeding at a decent pace.
3. Learned State counsel on instructions submits that an earnest effort would be made to examine all prosecution witnesses within six months from the date fixed before the trial Court.
4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the State, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition at this stage.
5. Dismissed as withdrawn.
6. There is no doubt that in case a request is made before the court concerned for accommodating the date for examining the prosecution witnesses, the same would be considered in accordance with law.
7. Since the main case has been withdrawn, the pending application(s), if any is rendered infructuous.
