Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though, in the present petition, the challenge is to the order of compulsory retirement dated 22.06.2023 (Annexure P/5) but as the petitioner already preferred an appeal before the higher authorities, copy of which has been appended with the present petition as Annexure P/2, the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage in case the appellate authority is directed to decide the said appeal in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case an appeal Annexure P/2 has been received in the office of respondent No.2 and the same is still pending consideration, an appropriate speaking order on the same will be passed within a period of six weeks from today and in case after the decision, the petitioner is found entitled for any relief, the same will

also be extended to him within a further period of four weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by the learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further at this stage.
