By this order, two Civil Writ Petitions i.e CWP-22954 of
2022 and CWP-25831 of 2022 shall stand disposed of.

Learned counsel representing the parties are ad idem that
these two writ petitions can conveniently be disposed of in terms of the
order passed in CWP-18383-2022 titled as '**Surinder Pal vs. State of
Punjab and others**' decided on 22.08.2022. The operative part of the

order dated 22.08.2022 reads as under:-

“The petitioner is stated to be suffering from permanent disability which has been assessed at 50%. There appears to be merit in the contention of the learned counsel for respondent No.3 that the disability of the petitioner needs to be examined from a Specialist.

Consequently, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Director, PGIMER, Chandigarh to constitute a Board of Doctors to examine the disability of the petitioner and send a report to respondent No.3 in this regard. The needful shall be done within a period of 10 days. Respondent No.3 would consider the report and pass an appropriate order in accordance with law within a period of one week thereafter.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he shall inform the Director, PGIMER, Chandigarh of the order of this Court by tomorrow.

The petitioner shall not be relieved from service till final order in the afore-noted terms is passed by respondent No.3.”

Keeping in view the consensus arrived at between the learned counsel representing the parties, the writ petitions are disposed of in the same terms as in CWP-18383-2022 titled as ‘**Surinder Pal vs. State of Punjab and others**’ decided on 22.08.2022.

It has been informed by the learned counsel representing respondent no.2 and 3 that pursuant to the order dated 21.11.2022, a Medical Board has already been constituted by the Director, Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education and Research, Chandigarh. Hence, let the petitioner be examined by the Board of Doctors on 11.01.2023 and the report shall be collected by the representative of

respondent no.2 from the office of the Director, Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education and Research, Chandigarh. Thereafter, respondent no.2 shall consider the report and pass appropriate speaking order.

Disposed of.

Till then, the petitioner shall continue in the service.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
