Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.158 dated 17.7.2022 registered under Sections 341, 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Civil Lines, Patiala, District Patiala.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that only simple injury is attributed to the petitioner who has joined the investigation with the police in compliance of previous order of interim bail.

State counsel on instructions from SI Ram Karan has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by the counsel for the petitioner and further submits that the petitioner got effected recovery of the weapon used in the commission of the crime and is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 10.10.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
