This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction especially a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to take appropriate action and to lodge the FIR under relevant sections against respondents No.8 to 10 for committing misappropriation, embezzlement of funds and the record of the Gram Panchayat of village Dudala, Block Jandiala Guru, now Block Verka, District Amritsar.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr. Kulbir Singh, SEPO, has pointed out that in the present case, an inquiry has been done by the DDPO and the same has been forwarded to the Director, Department of Rural Development and Panchayat, Punjab and the action

in accordance with law will be taken by the Director, Department of Rural Development and Panchayat, Punjab, as expeditiously as possible, preferably, within a period of three months.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that on account of the said statement made by learned State counsel, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may be disposed of as such.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.

The respondent-State would be bound by the statement made before this Court.
