The present petition has been filed for directing the respondents to grant the pay scale from the date of joining into the service with the respondent-department as regular and permanent on the post of Patwari.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after the filing of the petition, vide order dated 01.09.2023, the petitioner has already been given the grade pay of ₹2400/- instead of ₹1900/- hence, the grievance raised in the present petition qua grade pay scale stands redressed and is no longer pressed. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner had not been given increment for the year 2018-2019 and that too without any valid justification hence, the respondents are directed to grant the said benefit along with arrears.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the claim as raised in the present petition qua the non-grant of arrears has already been raised vide Legal Notice dated 12.07.2023 (Annexure P-6) but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Pankaj Middha, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the legal notice dated 12.07.2023 (Annexure P-6) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may be disposed of as having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
