JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. On 04.09.2023, the following order was passed:

“The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to correct his Date of Birth in the passport.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that by mistake, Date of Birth of the petitioner has been recorded in the passport as 15.01.1974 whereas actual Date of Birth of the petitioner is 15.04.1974.”

2. Learned counsel for the respondents-Union of India submits that petitioner has been directed to appear before the passport authority on 16.10.2023. If petitioner submits all the requisite documents on the said date, the competent authority would look into the matter and pass an appropriate order within 6 weeks thereafter.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner agrees with aforesaid arrangement.
4. In the wake of statements of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of.
