VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to provide the RTI information to the petitioner.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after annexing the relevant documents, including the order passed by the Financial Commissioner dated 27.09.2021 and 17.06.2020 and also after referring to the relevant provisions of law to assist the Court as to what other order could be passed by the State Information Commissioner, Haryana other than imposing the penalty of Rs.25,000/- and initiating disciplinary action against the concerned authority which has already been done, in the facts and circumstances of the case to direct respondent no.4 to provide the information sought.
3. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
4. In case any such petition is filed, the same would be considered independently on its merit.
