Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.50, dated 20.06.2023, under Sections 307, 506, 148, 149 of IPC and Section 25(6) of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Tibber, District Gurdaspur.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is not named in the FIR. It is co-accused Sahibdeep Singh @ Deep, who is alleged to have used pistol and fired upon a car hitting wind shield of the car of the complainant. Learned counsel further contends that petitioner has been nominated on the basis of disclosure statement of said Sahibdeep Singh @ Deep, as per which petitioner had supplied the pistol to him, though petitioner was not present at the spot of crime.

Notice of motion.

Mr. R.S. Khaira, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Learned State counsel concedes that there is no attribution to the petitioner except the fact that the supplied the pistol to co-accused Sahibdeep Singh @ Deep and that said attribution is also emerged during the disclosure statement of Sahibdeep Singh @ Deep.

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As per custody certificate placed on record by learned State counsel, petitioner is in custody for the last 01 month and 29 days in this case, though involved in two more cases.

Having regard to the role attributed to the petitioner in this case, but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case, he is admitted to bail. He is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
