In the backdrop of settlement between the parties, the Insurance Company has not opposed the condonation of delay of 19 days in filing the present appeal at any juncture and as such, in view of the settlement that has been arrived between the parties, the delay in filing the appeal is condoned.

On 21.07.2023, on behalf of the appellant statement (separately recorded), was made by learned counsel for the appellant to accept Rs.7,35,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakh Thirty Five Thousand only) more, over and above, the amount awarded by the MACT concerned, in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. Today, on behalf of the Insurance Company concurrence has been given to this effect.

Accordingly, Rs.7,35,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakh Thirty Five Thousand only) is allowed as further compensation over and above the compensation already awarded by the MACT.

We dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque in the sum of Rs.7,35,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakh Thirty Five Thousand only) in the name of the appellant-Hanuman with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 06.09.2023 failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a. from the date of this order till the cheque is deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat. The appellants' counsel/appellant may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied /sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
