This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to the Commissioner of Police, Sonipat-respondent No.3 to consider and decide the petitioner's complaint/representation dated 25.08.2023 (Annexure P-1) and investigate the matter.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner restricts her prayer to the limited extent of taking steps to locate her missing husband, though in the complaint/representation dated 25.08.2023 (Annexure P-1), petitioner has prayed for initiating search of her missing husband as well as taking action against Smt. Mukesh wife of Prem. Qua other prayer in the representation, i.e. taking action against Smt. Mukesh wife of Prem, counsel prays that liberty be granted to the petitioner to avail her statutory remedy in accordance with law. Counsel

submits that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Commissioner of Police, Sonipat-respondent No.3, to search for her missing husband.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Gurbir S. Dhillon, A.A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and waives service.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

In light of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the matter or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Sonipat-respondent No.3, to look into the matter and initiate search for the missing husband of the petitioner without loss of time. However, qua the other prayer not pressed before this Court i.e. for taking action against Smt. Mukesh wife of Prem, who has not been impleaded as party respondent in the present petition, petitioner would be at liberty to avail the statutory remedy, in accordance with law.

Disposed of with above direction.
