1. The petitioner by way of this Writ Petition assails the notices issued to her whereby she has been asked to give explanation with regard to the complaint relating to her appointment/promotion.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has submitted a representation to the Director, Social Security and Women and Child Development, Punjab which is pending.

3. This Court finds that the petitioner is holding the post of Anganwari Worker and the said post falls under the Women and Child Department Scheme. No final order has been passed against the petitioner and if any order is passed adverse to her, she always has a right to challenge the said orders in Appeal before the appellate forum as available under the Rules governing her services.

4. In view thereof, no case is for interference of this Court is made out.

5. The Writ Petition is devoid of merits and accordingly **dismissed.**
6. All pending application(s), shall stand(s) disposed of.
