The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus ordering the release of the family members of the petitioner from the illegal custody of respondent No.3 by appointing a Warrant Officer to secure the release of the said detainee and their restoration to the petitioner.

Vide order dated 01.09.2023 passed by this Court, Warrant Officer was appointed in this case. Report from Warrant Office has been received. Relevant portion of said report dated 03.09.2023 is reproduced herein below:

“It is submitted that alleged detainees has not been found as house arrest and residence of the petitioner not guarded by police, at the time of my visit. They were sleeping in a room in their house along with children. Mr. Sukhdev Singh and Mr. Manjeet Singh, relative/friends of the petitioner (accompanied with undersigned) give joint statement in this regard (Annexure 'C') in writing stating therein that they are

present along with the warrant officer at the time of visit and they are open the door of the house, no police official found in the house, they do not know where is the police officials, they meet to Ms. Ajmer Kaur, Manpreet Kaur and Satwinder Kaur along with children, now found they are safe in the house.”

In view of the above, no further order is required to be passed in the present petition. Therefore, the present petition is rendered as infructuous and dismissed as such.
