The petitioner while praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari, prays for quashing the appointment letter issued to respondent no.5, who is 100% physically handicapped.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner contends that respondent no.5, being 100% disabled, is unable to perform the duties of an Anganwadi Worker, which requires visiting the houses of the residents in the village.

Yesterday, the learned State counsel was requested to take complete instructions. Today, he has produced the disability certificate of respondent no.5 issued by the Senior Medical Officer to the effect that she is fit enough to perform the duties of an Anganwadi Worker.

In view of the aforesaid, no ground to issue the writ, as prayed for, is made out.

Hence, dismissed.
