1. The petitioner has filed present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.88 dated 17.07.2023, registered under Sections 20/61/85 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (Section 29 of NDPS Act added later on), at Police Station Amargarh, District Malerkotla.
