1. Learned counsel for the parties are ad idem that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties for a lump sum amount of Rs.4,00,000/- in settlement of all claims of the respondent No.2 towards the petitioner-Bank.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since the matter has been amicably settled, respondent No.2 can either personally visit the concerned office of the Bank to collect the amount or supply the details of his bank account wherein the amount shall be transferred within a period of three weeks from the date when his details are supplied.
3. In view of the amicable settlement arrived at between the parties, the instant writ petition is accordingly disposed of with a direction that the parties shall remain bound with the aforesaid settlement.
4. All pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
