This appeal has been filed by the appellant-wife challenging judgment dated 01.04.2017 passed by the learned District Judge, Family Court, Barnala whereby petition under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short 'the Act') filed by the respondent-husband was allowed.

Learned counsel for the parties submit that during pendency of this appeal, the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. Terms and conditions of settlement have been reduced in writing on 19.12.2022. Copy of the settlement-agreement is taken on record as Annexure A-1.

Learned counsel for the parties submit that the compromise has been acted upon. Land measuring 2 kanals and 4

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kanals have been transferred by the appellant and her son respectively to the respondent/3rd party. A sum of Rs.20 lakhs has been transferred by the respondent in favour of the appellant and the son born out of this wedlock.

It is further submitted that petition under Section 13-B of the Act has been filed. Statement of parties at first motion has been recorded and matter is pending for 04.08.2023 for recording the statements of the parties at second motion. It is thus prayed that the present appeal be disposed of in terms of agreement dated 19.12.2022.

Ordered accordingly.

Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
