The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to trial Court in case FIR No. 30 dated 16.06.2016 under Section 307, 323, 341, 148 & 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Gardhiwal, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1) to decide the matter within two months.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset submits that he has confined his request in the present petition to the limited aspect that the petitioner will move the specific application before the learned trial Court taking up all the pleas, which have been taken in the present petition, qua the disposal of the cancellation report in an expeditious manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Swati Batra, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondent/State.

After considering the facts and circumstances of the case and limited request made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting on the merits of the petition, the petition is hereby disposed of thereby granting liberty to the petitioner to take up all the pleas, which are taken in the present petition, before learned trial Court and trial Court will make earnest efforts to dispose of the same in an expeditious manner, preferably within a period of two months from the date of application filed in trial Court.

6. The instant petition is disposed of with the liberty aforesaid.
