1. This appeal has been filed by the appellant-husband challenging judgment and decree dated 09.03.2018, passed by learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Faridabad, whereby his petition under Section 13 (ia) of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (hereinafter referred to as the Act), has been dismissed.

2. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties and they have decided to part ways and seek dissolution of their marriage by way of mutual consent under Section 13-B of the Act. In view of the settlement, he seeks to withdraw this appeal with liberty to the appellant to file appropriate application in case, terms and conditions of the settlement are not adhered to by respondent.

3. Though, learned counsel for the respondent submits that she has no instructions in this matter, we find no justification for continuation of these proceedings. Appeal is accordingly dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforementioned.
