Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.166 dated 22.08.2019, registered for offences under Sections 452, 450, 326, 324, 323 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Dharamkot, Moga, Annexure P-1, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of the compromise dated 11.09.2019, Annexure P-2, arrived at between the parties.
2. State counsel has placed on record a copy of judgment dated 03.10.2023 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Moga to submit that trial has concluded and the accused-petitioners have been acquitted of the charges framed against them. He submits that the petition has become infructuous.
