NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondent Nos.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 6 and not to harass and threaten them at the behest of respondent Nos.4 to 6.

On issuance of notice of motion, status report dated 01.12.2022, by way of an affidavit of Mr. Shamsher Singh, H.P.S., Deputy Superintendent of Police, Punhana has been filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3, which is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to the learned counsel for the petitioners.

Relevant Para nos.2 and 3 of the report are as under:-

2. That in compliance to the order passed by the Punjab and Haryana High Court the answering respondent got inquired into the matter through investigating officer Punhana.

During the course of inquiry petitioner No.1 and 2 joined the inquiry and stated that they had solemnized their marriage with their own consent and will. Earlier they had apprehending of danger from the private respondent, hence they filed the present petition. Now they do not have any apprehension of danger either from the private respondent or anyone. Now they are residing peacefully and happily as Husband and wife in Naharpur. True translation of the Statement are annexed herewith as Annexure R-1 & R-2.

3. That it is humbly submitted that during the course of inquiry all the private respondents also joined the inquiry and stated that they do not have any objection with the marriage of petitioner Nos.1 and 2 and petitioners do not have any danger from them. They further stated that neither they threatened nor harm them nor they will do so in future. The true translation of the statement is annexed herewith as Annexure R-3 to R-5.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that in view of the averments made in the above paras No.2 & 3 of the status report, no further cause of action survives.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed off as having become infructuous.
