Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.38, dated 24.05.2023, under Sections 307, 326, 324, 323, 148, 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

It is contended by learned counsel that this is the case of version and cross version. The matter has since been compromised amongst the parties. Copy of that compromise is Annexure P-3.

Learned counsel further contends that a petition bearing No.CRM-M-36601-2023 (O&M) has already been filed for quashing of the present FIR on the basis of compromise.

Notice of motion.

Mr. R.S. Khaira, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-State.

As per custody certificate placed on record by learned State counsel, the petitioner is in custody for the last 03 months and 12 days. He has no criminal antecedent.

Having regard to the compromise (Annexure P-3) placed on record and the fact that quashing petition has already been filed before

this Court, but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case, the petitioner is admitted to bail and he is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
