1. Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus for directing respondent No.1 for making necessary corrections in the First Year Mark Sheet (Annexure P-2) dated 27.09.2017, Second Year Mark Sheet (Annexure P-3) dated 26.10.2018 and the Diploma Certificate (Annexure P-4) dated 27.05.2019 issued by respondent No.1 in the name of petitioner by affixing correct photograph of the present petitioner and issue fresh Diploma Certificate and mark sheets both of the first and the second year to the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the

petitioner had raised his grievances before respondent No.2-College and respondent No.2-College forwarded the same to respondent No.1-Board for carrying out necessary corrections, vide letter dated 24.03.2023 (Annexure P-5) and the petitioner would be satisfied in case the competent authority of respondent No.1-Board takes a final decision on the letter dated 24.03.2023 (Annexure P-5), as expeditiously as possible and in case the pleas raised by the petitioner are found to be meritorious, then, to grant him appropriate relief.

3. Learned State counsel appearing for respondent No.1-Board has submitted that the competent authority of respondent No.1-Board would take a final decision on the letter dated 24.03.2023 (Annexure P-5), in accordance with law and the same would be done within a period of four weeks from the date of certified copy of this order.

4. Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority of respondent No.1-Board to take a final decision on the letter dated 24.03.2023 (Annexure P-5) within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and in case the competent authority is of the view that the pleas raised by the petitioner are meritorious, then, the necessary relief be granted to the petitioner as expeditiously as possible and in case, the competent authority is of the view that the pleas raised by the petitioner are meritless, then, a speaking order rejecting the claim be passed within the aforesaid period of four weeks.

5. It is made clear that this Court has not opined on the merits of the case and the competent authority of respondent No.1-Board would

consider and decide the matter independently, in accordance with law.
