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approached this Court for transfer of investigation. It has been submitted that on the day of occurrence, the deceased had made a telephonic call to her elder sister and sister-in-law wherein she had specified allegations with regard to maltreatment being given to her on account of demand of dowry and furthermore, expressed her apprehension that she may be killed by the family members of her in-laws. The deceased and the petitioner had been residing in the same house where the occurrence took place.

5. It is significant to note that the death took place within a period of about 05 months of the marriage. The deceased is the daughter-in-law of the petitioner. Both of them had been residing in the same house where occurrence took place. As per the version of the complainant, the deceased has informed her elder sister and sister-in-law on the day of occurrence that she was being maltreated on account of demand of dowry and there was apprehension that she may be killed. The matter requires thorough probe and investigation and no extraordinary circumstances are made out to extend the concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

6. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
