RAVI SHANKER JHA, C.J. (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for the appellant, after arguing at length, submits that the appellant be permitted to approach the respondent-authorities by filing a representation, as he wishes that the matter be considered by the authorities on sympathetic grounds.
2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the representation, if any, filed by the petition would be considered and decided by respondent No.4, expeditiously, in accordance with law.
3. In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the appellant and the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the appeal stands disposed of. However, it is made clear that this Court has not, in any manner, modified the impugned order and judgment rendered by the learned

Single Judge. Thus, the authorities would be at liberty to consider the representation of the appellant, if so filed, at their end, in accordance with law.
