The appellants are present in person and their identity has been verified by learned counsel for the Insurance Company supported by photocopy of Aadhaar Card.

Both the parties have agreed for full and final settlement with the enhanced compensation at Rs.5,50,000/- (Rupees Five Lacs and Fifty Thousand only) over and above the amount awarded by the learned MACT, Tarn Taran.

The enhanced amount is to be credited to the account of the claimants within a period of four weeks from today. The claimants have undertaken to provide the bank details enabling the respondent-Insurance Company to credit the amount through RTGS within a week.

In case the appellants/claimants fail to provide the bank details for the purpose of transfer of amount so enhanced hereinabove, the Insurance Company will be at liberty to issue demand draft against the said amount.

It is further made clear that in case the Insurance Company fails to deposit the amount of enhanced compensation within the stipulated period of four

weeks, it shall carry interest @ 9% per annum from the date it became due till the date of its realization.

Ms. Sunita Rani has stated that I have a joint account with my husband Sh. Swaran Singh and has no objection in case the amount of compensation is transferred to the joint account held by both of them. Therefore, the amount is ordered to be transferred through RTGS in the said bank account. The details of which shall be given to the counsel for Insurance Company and a photocopy of the passbook has also been placed on record here. The amount shall be transferred within a period of 4 weeks from today.

Lok Adalat Branch of this Court shall inform the appellants directly with regard to the deposit of amount, which shall be transferred to the account of the appellants by RTGS.

The present appeal is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.

A copy of this order be supplied to the respective counsel for the parties and file be returned to the High Court.
