1. The correctness of the concurrent findings of fact arrived at by the courts below is assailed by the plaintiff in this Regular Second Appeal. He filed a suit for the grant of mandatory injunction directing the respondents to pay arrears of increments on account of retrospective promotion and for revising the pensionary benefits. The appellant retired as a Sub Inspector on 31.11.2011. On 12.06.2012, the Deputy Inspector General of Police, Ferozepur Range, Ferozepur, passed an order promoting the appellant as an Inspector notionally. His pay etc. have been revised for the purpose of the pensionary benefits. However, as per the orders, the arrears have not been paid in view of the instructions issued by the State Government dated 14.01.1999. There is no challenge to the correctness of the instructions issued by the State Government on 14.01.1999, which have been relied upon by the Deputy Inspector General of Police.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no ground to interfere is made out.

Hence, dismissed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
