Only grievance of the petitioner is that despite the matter being reported, the police has failed to register any FIR against the accused persons who trespassed into her agricultural land and damaged the growing crop and tried to take forcible possession of the property belonging to the petitioner.

2. After arguing for sometime, counsel for the petitioner made prayer that he be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail appropriate remedy as per provisions of Section 156(3) of Cr.P.C. Prayer is not opposed by the State counsel.

3. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
