Status report by way of affidavit of Ms.Ritika Arora, District Town Planner (Regulatory), Kapurthala has been filed. The same is taken on record.

2. It has been averred in the said affidavit that notice dated 18.04.2023 was issued and thereafter, demolition order was passed by the competent authority-cum-Addl.Deputy Commissioner (G) Kapurthala on 12.07.2023 against Smt.Manpreet Kaur wife of Amandeep Singh Gill. An appeal had been filed against the demolition order but in the absence of any stay, the unauthorized construction raised in Village Pandori Arian, Tehsil Bholath, District Kapurthala had been demolished. It has further been averred that orders dated 14.03.2023 of this Court and 12.07.2023 of competent authority had been complied with and photographs of the demolition of the construction has been appended as Annexure R-2/6 (Colly.).

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3. Mr.Bajwa has also handed-over copies of the coloured photographs.
4. Counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the averments made in the affidavit, he does not wish to press the present writ petition and prays that the same may be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
5. Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. All pending applications also stand disposed of.
