The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.180 dated 05.09.2022 registered under Sections 341, 324, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (to which Section 307 of the IPC added later on) at Police Station Sadar Kharar, SAS Nagar.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ranjit Singh, submits that in pursuance of order dated 29.10.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 29.10.2022 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
