AMAN CHAUDHARY. J.

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.94, dated 06.05.2023, registered under Sections 307, 459, 323, 506, 148 and 149 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station City-1 Sangrur, District Sangrur.
2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court and prays that his bail application be directed to be decided within a time bound manner.
