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KARAMJIT SINGH, J. (Oral)

1. Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case having FIR No.845 dated 27.9.2022 registered under Sections 380, 427, 457, 34, 506 IPC at Police Station Sirsa (City) District Sirsa.
2. Vide detailed order dated 29.11.2022, the petitioner was granted interim bail with direction to join investigation with the police.

3. Today, counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined investigation with the police in compliance of previous order of interim bail passed by this Court.
4. The counsel for the complainant while contesting the present petition submits that the petitioner actively participated in the occurrence, which took place on 26.9.2022 along with her husband and has been specifically named in the FIR.
5. State counsel on instructions from ASI Inder Singh has submitted that the petitioner who has joined investigation is not required by police for further investigation or for custodial interrogation.
6. Admittedly the petitioner is a lady aged about 29 years and is not required by the police for any further investigation. In the given circumstance, no purpose is going to be served by subjecting the petitioner to custodial interrogation. Thus without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby allowed and order dated 29.11.2022 is hereby made absolute. The petitioner should abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
