JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent No.3 to re-issue him passport.

2. The petitioner vide application dated 16.08.2022 has applied for the passport. The passport has not been issued on account of pendency of FIR. An FIR No.12 dated 14.01.2019, under Sections 323, 336, 341, 506 and 34 of IPC and Section 27 of Arms Act, 1959 was registered against the petitioner. The police has filed cancellation report, however, Trial Court has asked the police to make further investigation.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that case of the petitioner is squarely covered by Judgment dated 14.07.2023 passed by

this Court in *Mohan Lal @ Mohna vs. Union of India and others*, CWP No. 27167 of 2018.

4. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Malkeet Singh confirms that police after completing investigation has twice filed cancellation report.
5. Faced with this, learned counsel for respondent-UOI submits that competent authority would pass an appropriate order within 6 weeks from today after considering judgment of this Court in *Mohan Lal @ Mohna* (supra).
6. In the wake of statements of both sides, the petition stands disposed of.
