KARAMJIT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.42 dated 21.7.2021 registered under Sections 420, 120-B IPC and Section 66D/75 of I.T. Act at Police Station Cyber Crime, District Gurugram.

The allegations in nutshell are that the police received secret information that some persons were running fake call centre in the area of Gurugram and then raid was conducted and co-accused Akshay Kumar and Bishoo Singh were arrested at the spot and all the equipments used in running of fake call centre were taken into possession by the police.

Counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and has nothing to do with the fake call centre and has already joined the investigation with the police.

State counsel on instructions from Inspector Surinder Singh

submits that indeed, the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police and further submits that all the gadgets which were recovered from the spot and were being used for running of call centre are taken into possession by the police and after completion of investigation, the police has presented the challan against co-accused Akshay Kumar and Bishoo Singh who were apprehended at the spot.

In view of the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and recoveries are already effected, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 4.4.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
